RE: NEW ADDRESS-BASED IRRIGATION SCHEDULE
Nolensville / College Grove Utility District Customers

Dear Irrigation/Landscaping companies and Customers of Nolensville/ College Grove Utility District,

The Nolensville/ College Grove Utility District is committed to ensuring a sustainable water supply while promoting efficient irrigation practices. As part of this effort, we are implementing a new **address-based irrigation schedule** for all automated irrigation systems starting in 2025.

We also request that you regularly check your automatic irrigation controller, as power outages and storms can often disrupt the scheduling.

What This Means for You:

Starting this year, all automated irrigation systems should be programmed based on your property address. Below is a detailed breakdown of the new schedule:

- **Odd-numbered addresses** will have the option to irrigate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- **Even-numbered addresses** will have the option to irrigate on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

If the location of the irrigation system does not have a numerical street address associated with it, please consider it to be Even.

This schedule does not apply to manual hand watering.

Reasons for the Change:

The current irrigation schedule primarily takes place on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings, resulting in high peak demand that necessitates expensive infrastructure upgrades. By distributing irrigation usage more evenly throughout the week, we aim to achieve the following objectives:

- ❖ Alleviate stress on the water system.
- ❖ Reduce long-term infrastructure costs.
- ❖ Ensure fair water rates for all consumers.

How You Can Contribute:

We kindly request the cooperation of all irrigation companies and residents within our utility district to adhere to the new irrigation schedule. Ideally, irrigation should be conducted during the early morning or late evening hours.

Your cooperation with this plan is essential for promoting responsible water management practices and ensuring the sustainability of our water supply.
